A benefit concert for the Rye Summer Piano Intensive Camp, all donations go to the scholarship fund. RSPI is a day camp for young pianists, aged 9-18, running from July 7-17. Executive director David Wold, Artistic Director Paul Dykstra, and Instructor Mary Towse-Beck provide individual lessons, master classes, music theory, lectures and a faculty recital. The camp culminates with a formal Student Recital on Thursday, July 16th. Friday, July 17th, is an extra half-day of games and outdoor activities celebrating our five years.

Originally from Ohio, Mary Towse-Beck moved to New Hampshire in 2007 after living in England for nearly twenty years. She has performed as both soloist and collaborative artist in Europe, Australia and the United States. She has been a featured artist on NPR and Australian Public Radio, and her recent CD, *The Impressionists*, has received extensive airplay throughout North America. Locally, Mary has performed with the Aliento Chamber Players and last year appeared as soloist with the Portsmouth Symphony.
